## Delores Levine Memorial Scholarship

About the scholarship:

The Dolores Levin Memorial Scholarship's mission is to fund individual scholarships, for deserving art teachers, who would not otherwise be able to afford the cost of participation in classes and seminars offered by the La Romita School. Priority will go to current art teachers. Maximum award for any individual is \$3500.

The **Delores Levin Memorial Scholarship** is available to any eligible visual arts participant.

To be eligible for an award from the Delores Levin Memorial Scholarship, applicants must:

- Be a United States citizen or a permanent legal resident.
- Be at least 18 years old.
- Be an art teacher at any age or expertise level.
- Complete the application and submit to [scholarships@laromita.org](mailto:scholarships@laromita.org)
- Agree to participate in future promotion to be determined prior to accepting the scholarship. This could be the production of a blog during your workshop, or speaking about your experience the following year to a small group of possible attendees.

Please include:

- 1.) The application form, completed, signed, and dated (scans are ok).
- 2.) a one-page CV or resumé that summarizes your professional or academic background
- 3.) a one-page statement explaining why you would like the scholarship and how it will impact your teaching practice.
- 4.) 1-2 samples of your work from your portfolio. If you do not yet have a portfolio, write a statement about 2 or 3 works you wish you could create and why.
- 5.) 1-2 samples of your students work with explanation of your teaching that led to the work. If you do not yet have students, please include evidence of coursework in Art Education.

Applications will be accepted until April 1<sup>st</sup> for that calendar season – I.E. the cutoff to apply for scholarships to be awarded in 2017 is April 1<sup>st</sup> 2017.
